Presenters are cautioned that statements or representation concerning others that convey an unjust, unfavorable impression may subject the presenter to civil action for defamation. Policies KE, KEB, and KEC are provided by the Board for disposition of legitimate complaints, including those involving individuals.

EXECUTIVE SESSION
